Furlough Help

People often ask how they can help us while we are on furlough. During furlough we travel a lot, we speak a lot and we have the problem of setting up and closing down a house two times in one year - all this while we continue to raise our family. We also receive the same compensation that we do while we live in Manila which often leaves us short of funds for routine expenses.

What things really help the most? First of all you can introduce us to your friends, your pastor, and your church mates. We have to raise the required financial support before we can return to the field for our next term. After 8 years, we have spoken to everyone we know. Have we spoken to everyone you know? Some of our best supporters can't afford to give, but they introduce us to others who can. Other kinds of giving also help us to get through the year in the US; garden produce, that left over venison in the freezer, or a little gas money go a long ways toward helping us to make ends meet.

If we are not able to line up a mission house, another way to help is to loan furniture, bedding, dishes, etc. to us. We don't want to buy things - just borrow it and then give it back at

the end of furlough. That solves the problem of setting up and of closing down all in one.
